Preliminary unemployment rates released by the U.S. Bureau of Labor and Statistics again show an increase in joblessness in the tri-county area, with Gloucester County topping 10 percent unemployment for the first time since at least 1990.

Numbers for July show an unemployment rate of 10.1 percent in Gloucester County, compared with 9.7 percent in June. Last July, unemployment was 5.9 percent in Gloucester County...

In the tri-county region, Camden County leads the way in unemployment, according to the preliminary numbers. July's unemployment rate was 10.8 percent in Camden County...

Gloucester, Salem and Cumberland jobless approach 17% when part-time workers and those who give up going to the unemployment office are counted. Violent crimes rises at alarming pace in Cumberland. Thanks to elected officials (Burzichelli/Riley) your county ranks last.
